## 3. MTSS

\*Recommendation for the schedule

-MTSS is a Reg. Ed initiative, not a spec. ed. Initiative

-Master scheduling is extremely important in helping reg ed teachers have time outside of core instruction for intervention prior to bringing students to team. We have **one I/E** time. Most schools have moved to two of these "flex" times to provide intervention outside of core instruction time. This will also help specialists have time to help our students with the greatest needs.

-MTSS met Thursday: discussion is consistent with **strengthening the core** across the state and the district. Using two "flex" times w/o giving them specific names so that students can be served the interventions they need.

-How do we make this effective for all of our students' w/o over-burdening our staff? Need to make a commitment to meeting the needs of **all students.** Our best work will have to be put forth to provide effective instruction to move everyone forward.

-Is the SIT team behind the schedule? Is this the direction we want to go?
