*Grade 6 ALL TEST moved to 2nd in the state rankings from 4th in 17-18.

* Math 1 moved to 22nd from 44th with the Math 9-12 assessments.

* 115 local educational agencies in North Carolina -LEAs

*Elementary School state rankings are compared against PK – 6 and OK – 6 schools across the state.

*Middle school state rankings are compared against 7-8 schools across the state.

*High school state rankings are compared to traditional 9-12 across the state and the 24 regional high schools. Charter schools are not included in the comparison.

*District rankings are from the Northwest State Board Region. Alexander County Schools, Alleghany County Schools, Ashe County Schools, Avery County Schools, Burke County Schools, Caldwell County Schools, Catawba County Schools, Hickory City Schools, McDowell County Schools, Mitchell County Schools, Newton Conover City Schools, Watauga County Schools, Wilkes County Schools and Yancey County Schools make up the Northwest District 7 Region.

SCHOOL PERFORMANCE GRADES BREAKDOWN

- 80% of the weight of the school performance grade is based on test results from end-of-grade, end-of-course, graduation rate, and college/workplace readiness measures.
- 20% of the weight of the school performance grade is based on school growth as measured by SAS EVAAS (Education Value-Added Assessment System).
- The performance scores are converted to a 100-point scale and then used to determine a school performance grade of A, B, C, D or F. Recent legislation was passed allowing performance grades to continue to be based on a 15-point grading scale. More than 30% of North Carolina's approximately 2,500 public schools received a school performance grade of A or B for the 2018-2019 school year.

Rules for Effectiveness Level Determination

Exceeds Expected Growth: Significant evidence that the school's students made more progress than the Growth Standard (the school's index is 2 or greater)

Meets Expected Growth: Evidence that the school's students made progress similar to the Growth Standard (the school's index is between -2 and 2)

Does Not Meet Expected Growth: Significant evidence that the school's students made less progress than the Growth Standard (the school's index is less than -2)
