

## MINUTES

### ASHE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION

October 5, 2009

The October meeting was held at the Board of Education Annex as scheduled with all members present. Chairman King called the meeting to order, welcomed those in attendance, and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion by Mr. Weaver and a second by Dr. Beckworth gave unanimous approval to the agenda for the meeting.

A motion by Mrs. Witherspoon and a second by Dr. Beckworth gave unanimous approval to the minutes for the regular meeting of the Board on September 14, 2009.

Superintendent Reeves presented the school systems first *Ashe County Schools Employee of the Month Award* for October to Mrs. Cindy Pugh, custodian at Blue Ridge.

Each board of education was invited by the North Carolina School Boards Association (NCSBA) to nominate their board of county commissioners for the *NCSBA County Commissioners Award* for service to the local community through outstanding support of public education. The Board nominated the Ashe Board of County Commissioners for this award. Superintendent Reeves read the letter of nomination and presented Commissioner Judy Porter Poe, Chairman, and County Manager Dan McMillan with a certificate acknowledging the Ashe Board of County Commissioners' outstanding support and dedication to Ashe County Schools and its students and employees. If selected, this award will be presented at the Awards Ceremony at the November annual conference in Greensboro.

A motion by Dr. Beckworth and a second by Mr. Weaver gave unanimous approval to a request from Brandy B. to graduate early in December 2009.

A motion by Mrs. Witherspoon and a second by Mr. Jones gave unanimous approval to a request from Ashe High FFA for an overnight trip to attend the National FFA Convention in Indianapolis, Indiana, October 20-24, 2009.

A motion by Dr. Beckworth and a second by Mr. Jones gave a 4-1 vote to amend Policy 7730 *Employee Conflict of Interest*.

A motion by Mr. Jones and a second by Mrs. Witherspoon gave unanimous approval to the revised *Ashe County Schools Beginning Teacher Support Program Plan* as presented by Executive Director for Human Resources Rena Powers.

Superintendent Reeves presented policies *Code of Ethics for School Board Members* and *Harassment, Intimidation, Bullying, and Discrimination*. These policies will be discussed at the Fall Board Retreat in November.

A motion by Mrs. Witherspoon and a second by Mr. Jones gave unanimous approval to adopt the *Registered Sex Offenders* and the *Student Sex Offenders* policies as presented by Superintendent Reeves.
